Central PA World Hunger Association: The Central PA World Hunger Assoc. conducts a meat canning project each year in Lewistown, Pa. This is the 50th year of the canning project and we plan to process 30,000 lbs. of chicken. We use MCC'S portable meat canner and 90% of the meat gets distributed thru MCC to needs around the world. Ten percent of the meat stays in the local area to be used in food pantries, soup kitchens and various needs. All of our people are volunteers and all monies go to complete the project. The average cost to hold the event the last six years was around \$70,000, with meat being the main expense. We expect our needs to be higher this year with the price of meat being high. We appreciate any gift we receive and may God bless you as you give.

Mifflin-Juniata Energy Bank: Energy Bank provides heat assistance to residents of Mifflin or Juniata County ineligible for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) benefits. Services are tentatively available from November through the end of March. There is no income eligibility, but co-payment based on income does apply. Residents ages 60+ are eligible for Energy Bank assistance regardless of receipt of LIHEAP benefits. Financial health, energy conservation, and weatherization information is provided.

Milroy-Reedsville Meals on Wheels: Provides meals to approximately 60 elderly or disabled people in the Milroy and Reedsville areas.
